## Optional Schedules for Implementing Consolidation

### **Schedule 1:**

#### **Extend Effective Date of Consolidation to December 1998**

- The Mayor/Council campaign schedule will run from July-November 1997 (municipal election calendar).
- If consolidation is effective, the Mayor/Council will serve as such until December 1998 when their terms of office end and the newly elected Metro-Mayor and Metro-Council take office on the effective date of consolidation. (At the time candidates file for the office of Mayor/Council in July 1997: the General Assembly may not have adopted the Metro-Government Charter/enabling legislation; and the debt-assumption referendum required for consolidation to become effective will not have been held.)
- If consolidation is not effective because the Metro-Government Charter is not adopted or the debt assumption referendum fails, the Mayor/Council terms of office will be two years.
- If consolidation is effective, candidates for the Metro-Mayor and Metro-Council will follow a campaign schedule running from January-November 1998 (county election calendar). (Mayor/Council members who run for Metro-Mayor/Metro-Council will be campaigning almost nonstop from July 1997 through November 1998.)
- The Council will adopt a full, fiscal year budget for 1998-1999 for the City. The Board of County Commissioners will adopt a full, fiscal year budget for 1998-1999 for the County. For the balance of the fiscal year after consolidation is effective, the Metro-Government will administer the previously adopted City and County budgets.
- The first, elected Metro-Mayor and Metro-Council will serve for three years, until their successors are elected in November 2001 following a municipal election calendar. Thereafter, the Metro-Mayor and Metro-Council will be elected to two-year terms under a municipal election calendar in odd numbered years.

**Schedule 2:**

**Extend Effective Date of Consolidation to December 1998 and extended term of office for Mayor/Council**

- In the 1997 Session of the General Assembly, legislation will be adopted prior to July not only to consolidate the City and County but also to eliminate the 1997 elections for the Mayor/Council.
- If consolidation is effective, the Mayor/Council will serve as such until December 1998 when their terms of office end and the newly elected Metro-Mayor and Metro-Council take office on the effective date of consolidation. (Before this approach can work, all legislation necessary to consolidate the City and County and to eliminate the 1997 elections must be enacted prior to the time candidates file for office of Mayor/Council in July 1997; if the legislation eliminating the 1997 elections is not adopted prior to July 1997, considerable confusion may result.)
- If consolidation is not effective because the debt assumption referendum fails, the Mayor/Council terms of office will be four years. (An election for Mayor/Council would not be held again until 1999.)
- If consolidation is effective, candidates for the Metro-Mayor and Metro-Council will follow a campaign schedule running from January-November 1998 (county election calendar).
- The Council will adopt a full, fiscal year budget for 1998-1999 for the City. The Board of County Commissioners will adopt a full, fiscal year budget for 1998-1999 for the County. For the balance of the fiscal year after consolidation is effective, the Metro-Government will administer the previously adopted City and County budgets.
- The first, elected Metro-Mayor and Metro-Council will serve for three years, until their successors are elected in November 2001 following a municipal election calendar. Thereafter, the Metro-Mayor and Metro-Council will be elected to two-year terms under a municipal election calendar in odd numbered years

**Schedule 3: Extend Effective Date of Consolidation to December 1999 and extended term of office for current Board of County Commissioners\***

- In the 1997 Session of the General Assembly, legislation will be adopted not only to consolidate the City and County but also to provide that if the debt assumption referendum is held in 1997 and passes, the members of the current Board of County Commissioners will serve until December 1999, the effective date of consolidation, and that there will be no election for County Commissioners in 1998.
- If consolidation is not effective because the debt assumption referendum fails, the members of the current Board of County Commissioners would serve a normal, two year term and the normal county election calendar from January-November 1998 would be followed.
- If consolidation is effective, the Board of County Commissioners will serve as such until December 1999 when their terms of office end and the newly elected Metro-Mayor and Metro-Council take office on the effective date of consolidation.
- The Council will adopt a full, fiscal year budget for 1999-2000 for the City. The Board of County Commissioners will adopt a full, fiscal year budget for 1999-2000 for the County. For the balance of the fiscal year after consolidation is effective, the Metro-Government will administer the previously adopted City and County budgets.
- The first, elected Metro-Mayor and Metro-Council will serve for two years, until their successors are elected in November 2001 following a municipal election calendar (July-November). Thereafter, the Metro-Mayor and Metro-Council will continue to be elected to two-year terms under a municipal election calendar in odd numbered years.

\* A potential problem in extending the time between the debt assumption referendum and the effective date of consolidation is that no, new general obligation debt could be incurred by the City, and perhaps by the County, during the interim since such new debt could not be assumed by the consolidated government without another debt assumption referendum.

# I. SUMMARY OF TECHNICAL CHANGES TO CHARTER AND LEGISLATION

The Charter and the Legislation To Accomplish Consolidation have been reviewed and a number of technical, non-substantive changes are proposed by staff which will improve the Charter and Legislation from a drafting perspective.

The changes from the version of the Charter and Legislation submitted by the Charter Commission are summarized below.

## Charter

**Sec.4-51:** The erroneous reference to Chapter 3 is changed to Chapter 2.

## Legislation

**Sec. 3, Article 1, Part 1(a):** All references to “effective date of the/this Charter” in this Part and all other portions of the Legislation are changed to “effective date of consolidation” because both references are to the same date and the latter phrase is a more descriptive term of the significance of that date (the other instances of this change are not referenced again in this summary). The sentence containing this reference is edited to conform with this change.

**Sec. 3, Article 1, Part 1(c):** The phrase “after the effective date of consolidation” is inserted for clarity.

**Sec. 3, Article 1, Part 2:** The phrase “immediately prior to the effective date of consolidation” is inserted for clarity.

**Sec. 3, Article 1, Part 3(d):** The Part is re-written for clarity.

**Sec. 3, Article 1, Part 3(e):** The phrase “in existence immediately prior to the effective date of consolidation” is inserted for clarity. The verb “is” is changed to “are” to correct a grammatical mistake.

**Sec. 3, Article 3, Part 12:** Sub-section (b) is added to clarify that the scheduled, 1998 primaries and elections will not be held for membership on the Board of County Commissioners. Existing Part 12 is designated as sub-section (a).

**Sec. 3, Article 4, Part 18:** The word “the” and the phrase “the 1998 elections” are inserted for clarity. In the bracketed, explanatory note, “at least two (2)” is changed to “three” to reflect the length of the terms actually used in this Part and “would” is changed to

“may” because the proposed change in the effective date of consolidation to July 1, 1998 would not cause a change in this Part (a change in the effective date to an odd-numbered year would require a change in this Part).

**Sec. 3, Article 4, Part 19:** A new part is added which provides for the organization of the initial meeting of the newly elected Metro-Council and Metro-Mayor. The newly elected Metro-Mayor has the responsibility to arrange for the oaths of office to be administered.

**Sec. 4:** This section is inserted to specify July 1, 1998 as the effective date of consolidation for purposes of clarity (and the current Sec. 4 is re-numbered to Sec. 5).

## II. SUMMARY OF CHANGES TO CHARTER APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

Relevant sections of the Charter submitted by the Charter Commission have been revised to conform with the changes approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

These changes are summarized below.

### Charter

**Sec. 2-1:** The number of members of the Metro-Council is changed from 11 to 13 and the number of district members from 6 to 8.

**Sec. 2-23(a):** The number of members of the Metro-Council needed for a quorum is changed from 6 to 7.

**Sec. 2-23(f):** The number of affirmative votes of members of the Metro-Council needed for favorable action is changed from a minimum of 6 to 7 and, in the event of a tie vote with the Mayor casting an affirmative vote, from 5 to 6.

**Sec. 2-23(g):** As a result of the change in Sec. 2-32 to authorize the Metro-Council to appoint and remove the Health Director, Director of Social Services and Director of Area Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Authority, these officials are added to the list of officials on whose employment or dismissal the Metro-Mayor may vote .

**Sec. 2-23(h):** As a result of the change in Sec. 2-32 to authorize the Metro-Council to appoint and remove the Health Director, Director of Social Services and Director of Area Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Authority, these officials are added to the list of officials whose employment by the Metro-Council cannot be vetoed by the Metro-Mayor. The number of affirmative votes of members of the Metro-Council needed to readopt an action vetoed by the Mayor is changed from 7 to 8.

**Sec. 2-32:** The list of Metro-Government officials appointed by the Metro-Council to serve at its pleasure is changed to include the Director of Area Mental Health Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Authority. The Metro-Council also is authorized to appoint and remove the Health Director and Director of Social Services.

**Sec. 3-21(b):** As a result of the change in Sec. 2-32 to authorize the Metro-Council to appoint and remove the Health Director, Director of Social Services and Director of Area

Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Authority, these officials are deleted from the list of officials appointed and removed by the Metro-Manager.

**Sec. 10-5:** The illustration referring to a change in the number of members of Council from 11 members to 13 members is changed to 13 and 15, respectively. The illustration referring to the resulting change in the quorum of the Metro-Council from 6 to 7 is changed to 7 and 8, respectively.

**Sec. 11-1(b):** The references to Districts 1 through 6 are changed by adding Districts 7 and 8 and the references to “[See Mecklenburg County Commissioner Districts Map, January 1994]” is changed to “[See District Plan 8-B, May, 1, 1996]”

### Legislation

No changes.

### III. SUMMARY OF PROPOSED CHANGES TO CHARTER AND LEGISLATION BY COUNCIL MEMBER BAKER

Relevant sections of the Charter and the Legislation To Accomplish Consolidation submitted by the Charter Commission have been revised to reflect the changes proposed by Council Member Charles Baker and some, but not all, of the changes approved by the Board of County Commissioners. The changes to the Charter and Legislation proposed by Council Member Baker have not been approved by the City Council. This summary is prepared solely for the purpose of facilitating the discussion of this proposal in light of the tight timetable for considering consolidation.

The changes proposed by Council Member Baker are summarized below; provided that this summary does not include those proposed changes which are consistent with the changes in the Charter approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

#### Charter

**Sec. 2-1:** Sub-section (b) is deleted as a result of the elimination of any transitional governing board and the remaining sub-section is no longer designated as sub-section (a).

**Sec. 2-23(g):** As a result of the change in Sec. 3-21(b) to authorize the Metro-Manager to appoint and remove the Health Director, Director of Social Services and Director of Area Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Authority, these officials are deleted from the list of officials on whose employment or dismissal the Metro-Mayor may vote.

**Sec. 2-23(h):** As a result of the change in Sec. 3-21(b) to authorize the Metro-Manager to appoint and remove the Health Director, Director of Social Services and Director of Area Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Authority, these officials are deleted from the list of officials whose employment by the Metro-Council cannot be vetoed by the Metro-Mayor.

**Sec. 2-32:** As a result of the change in Sec. 3-21(b) to authorize the Metro-Manager to appoint and remove the Health Director, Director of Social Services and Director of Area Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Authority, these officials are deleted from the list of officials appointed and removed by the Metro-Council.

**Sec. 3-21(b):** The list of Metro-Government officials whom the Metro-Manager is authorized to appoint and remove is changed to include the Health Director, Director of Social Services and Director of Area Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Authority.

## Legislation

**Sec. 3:** Articles 2 and 3 are deleted which provide for transitional governing boards composed of all of the members of the Board of Commissioners, the City Council and the Mayor. Article 4 is deleted as a separate article, and Part 18 of former Article 4 is re-designated as Section 4, Part 3. Article 5 is deleted as a separate article, and Parts 20-25 of former Article 5 are re-designated as Section 5, Parts 1-6 (the title of former Article 5 is retained as a descriptive heading). As a result, the designation of the sole remaining article as Article 1 is deleted (the title of former Article 1 is retained as a descriptive heading).

**Sec. 3, Part 1(c):** The phrase “[e]xcept as otherwise provided in this Act,” is deleted since the only referenced provision was deleted. Former Section 3, Article 2, Part 8 authorized the Transitional Governing Board to adopt personnel policies which would take effect on the effective date of consolidation. The “a” in “all,” the first word of this Part, is capitalized.

**Sec. 3, Part 3(f):** The reference to “June 30,” 1998 (also the day before July 1, 1998, the effective date of consolidation under the Legislation submitted by the Charter Commission) is changed to “December 6,” the day before the effective date proposed by Council Member Baker of December 7, 1998 (the date that the first elected Metro-Council and Metro-Mayor take office). The reference to “July 1,” 1998 (also to be the date of the creation of the Metro-Government) is changed to “December 7,” 1998. The phrases “the end of the fiscal year” and “the beginning of fiscal year 1999” are deleted as no longer necessary.

**Sec. 4:** A new section is added with a descriptive heading of “SPECIFIC TRANSITION PROVISIONS” which addresses the transition from separate governing bodies for the City and the County to a single governing body for the Metro-Government. The remaining sections are re-numbered as appropriate.

**Sec. 4, Part 1:** A new part is added which provides that the persons who are elected to be Mayor and members of the City Council in 1997 serve abbreviated, one (1) year terms until consolidation is effective on December 7, 1998.

**Sec. 4, Part 2:** A new part is added which provides that the persons who are elected to be members of the Board of Commissioners in 1996 serve their regular two (2) year terms until consolidation is effective on December 7, 1998. A portion of this part is former Section 3, Article 3, Part 12(b), as set forth in the Legislation attached to the Summary of Technical Changes to Charter and Legislation..

**Sec. 4, Part 3:** This Part is former Section 3, Article 4, Part 18. Under the bracketed note, the effective date of consolidation is changed from “July 1, 1998” to “December 7, 1998.”(A copy of these sections with the proposed technical changes designated by such markings is found in Part I. Summary of Technical Changes to Charter and Legislation.)

**Sec. 4, Part 4:** This Part is former Section 3, Article 4, Part 19.

**Sec. 4, Part 5:** A new part is added which provides that the 1998-99 budget ordinances of the City and County continue after the effective date of consolidation and are administered by the Metro-Government officials and employees for the remainder of the fiscal year, with the Metro-Council having the authority to amend the budget ordinances of the City or County for any purpose which the City or County could have amended their respective budget ordinances in the absence of consolidation. The provisions of the Charter concerning the mandatory allocation of costs and revenues to the Mecklenburg Service Area and to service districts will not apply to the administration of such budget ordinances by Metro-Government officials, since such provisions did not apply to those budget ordinances when adopted.

**Sec. 4, Part 6:** A new part is added which authorizes the Board of Commissioners and the City Council to create committees, employ consultants and take other actions reasonably necessary to plan for and implement the transition from separate City and County governments to the consolidated government.

**Sec. 5:** All references in this Section to "the first five (5) fiscal years" are changed to "the first five (5) full fiscal years" so that this Section does not apply to the 1998-99, separate budgets of the City and County which are administered by Metro-Government officials for the remaining portion of the 1998-99 fiscal year after the effective date of consolidation. All references to "Article" are changed to "Section" as a result of the re-designation of these provisions. The Parts in this Section and references thereto are re-designated as appropriate. (Each instance of these changes is not referenced in this summary).

**Sec. 5, Part 1:** The last sentence is added to clarify that the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999 is the first fiscal year to which these provisions apply.


**Sec. 5, Part 3(c):** With the change in the effective date of consolidation from the beginning of the 1998-99 fiscal year to December 7, 1998 and the resulting requirement for the City and County to each adopt a budget ordinance for the 1998-99 fiscal year, the reference to the "1997-98 budget ordinances" of the City and County is changed to "1998-99" in order to use the last budget ordinances adopted by the City and County prior to the effective date of consolidation.

**Sec. 5, Parts 4, 5:** With the change in the effective date of consolidation from the beginning of the 1998-99 fiscal year to December 7, 1998 and the resulting requirement for the City and County to each adopt a budget ordinance for the 1998-99 fiscal year, the references to "January 1, 1997" are changed to "January 1, 1998" in order to use the last January 1st prior to the adoption of the last, separate City and County budget ordinances as the beginning date for the time periods during which changes are measured in the Consumer Price Index and the population of Mecklenburg County.

**Sec. 6:** The effective date of consolidation is changed from "July 1, 1998" to "December 7, 1998."

# PLAN 8D-WESTSIDE










**Motion by Councilmember Charlie Baker**

**MOTION--Metro-Government Manager appoints directors of social services, health and area mental health**

I move that Council adopt a joint resolution with the County approving the Amended Preliminary Charlotte-Mecklenburg Metropolitan Government Charter and companion legislation, as approved by the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Charter Commission, with the following exceptions that:

the Metro-Government Council consist of 13 members, 8 to be elected by districts and 5 to be elected at-large, using District Plan 8-B;

the effective date of consolidation be December, 1998, the date that the newly elected Metro-Government Mayor and Metro-Government Council take office;

Articles 2 and 3 of the companion legislation be deleted which provide for the Mayor and members the Council and of the Board of County Commissioners to serve<sup>as</sup> the governing body of the Metro-Government until the election of the Metro-Government Mayor and Metro-Government Council; and

the City Attorney be authorized to make such revisions to the Amended Preliminary Charlotte-Mecklenburg Metropolitan Government Charter and companion legislation and the joint resolution as are necessary to implement this motion without further action by the Council.

## QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS ON CONSOLIDATION

The following questions and answers are based upon the Amended Preliminary Charter prepared by the 1994-95 Charlotte-Mecklenburg Charter Drafting Committee as amended by the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Charter Commission. These represent common questions raised in consolidations of other communities as well as expected questions applicable only to Charlotte-Mecklenburg.

### General Questions:

**1. What is consolidation?**

Consolidation is the formation of a different type of local government to provide services currently provided by the City of Charlotte and Mecklenburg County. Under consolidation, the powers, duties, rights, privileges, functions and immunities of the City of Charlotte would be consolidated with those of Mecklenburg County. The "Charlotte-Mecklenburg Metropolitan Government" or "Metro Government" would have all of the powers of both a city and a county and would perform all the duties and serve all the purposes required of counties under the Constitution and laws of the State of North Carolina.

**2. Why consider consolidation now?**

Currently over 80% of Mecklenburg's citizens are governed by both the Mecklenburg County Board of Commissioners and the Charlotte City Council. It is estimated that by 2000, this percentage will continue to be over 80%. Over the past several years, both governing bodies have raised the issue of whether or not this is the best way to serve the residents of Charlotte and Mecklenburg County. In 1994, the Charlotte City Council and Mecklenburg County Board of County Commissioners appointed a Charter Drafting Committee to draft a charter for a consolidated government. After completion of the preliminary charter, the two bodies appointed a Charter Commission to educate the residents and gain their input. Following public hearings held in March and April, 1996, the Charter Commission finalized the Preliminary Charter and presented it for approval to the City Council and County Commission. Upon approval of both governing bodies, the Charter Commission would have the authority to call for a vote of the people on this issue in November, 1996.

**3. What are the issues that consolidation addresses?**

Issues can be framed by posing the following series of questions:

Is the current form of government the best way to:

- set priorities for capital and operating expenditures?
- encourage citizens to run for office and vote?
- represent the community in dealing with other local governments, and the state and federal governments?
- ensure that local government is held accountable?
- deliver services?

**4. If there is a referendum, when would it be held and who gets to vote on consolidation?**

The earliest a referendum on consolidation could be held would be November 5, 1996. This would be a county-wide vote of all registered voters in Charlotte, the towns, and the unincorporated area.

**5. When would consolidation take place?**

The projected schedule is as follows:\*

**6. How would consolidation take place? All at once or gradually?**

Under the projected schedule consolidation would take place July 1, 1998. Most city and county departments have either already been functionally consolidated or do not duplicate services. There would be a transition plan to consolidate the few remaining departments and the duties of the two elected boards. The transition would

take place over a period of several months.

**7. What would the consolidated government be called?**

For legal purposes, it would be called the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Metropolitan Government. The names of Charlotte and Mecklenburg would continue to be used.

**8. Would the six towns be part of the consolidated government?**

No. The six towns would retain their own governments. The present spheres of influence agreements, stating areas in which the towns and the City of Charlotte can annex, would also be retained.

**9. How would the consolidated government be structured?**

There would be a Metro Council with a mayor and a specified number of council members elected at-large and by districts. The Metro Council would appoint a Metro Manager to handle the day-to-day administrative functions of the consolidated government.

**Finance and Tax Questions:**

**1. How would the consolidated government be funded?**

There would be a continuation of different taxing levels providing different levels of services. In addition, the consolidated government would receive State and Federal funds currently provided to both the City and County.

**-Urban Service District Tax** would replace the current City of Charlotte tax and would cover existing city services such as urban police services, solid waste collection, etc.

**-Suburban Service District Tax**, if levied, would be a tax on property in the suburban service district and would be similar to the suburban police tax currently being implemented by Mecklenburg County for the unincorporated area. Taxes could only be implemented to pay for services provided in the Suburban Service District that are different from those provided County-wide (i.e. suburban police services).

**-County-wide Tax** would replace the current County tax and provide for county-wide services such as environmental protection, schools, libraries, parks, social services, and health.

**2. Would there be an increase/decrease in property taxes because of consolidation?**

There would be a mandated savings of \$4 million each year for the first five years of consolidation. This is subject to being waived by a 3/4's vote of the Metro Council. Additional savings/costs would depend on how the City and County work forces are combined and would be decided by the Metro Council.

For residents of the Suburban Service District, the consolidated government would have the authority to provide some services earlier than normally occurs under annexation. An example of this is the authority to make transportation improvements if agreement is reached with the NC Department of Transportation to transfer this authority and State funding. If the cost of such services is greater than the State funding provided, then the consolidated government would also have the authority to levy taxes to cover these costs. For street maintenance in the suburban service district, the Metro Council could levy a tax county-wide or a suburban service district tax. For street improvements in the suburban service district, the Metro Council could issue general obligation bonds (upon passage of a county-wide bond issue) and levy a county-wide tax to pay the debt service on the bonds.

**3. Are there any new fees residents would have to pay?**

The consolidated government would have the authority to levy two fees on the residents and businesses in the Suburban Service District that are not currently being charged in the unincorporated area: the City's vehicle license fee and the City's business license fee. The City's vehicle license fee is currently \$30 (\$25 of which goes to support the transit system and \$5 of which goes to the general fund). The City's business license fee schedule is higher than Mecklenburg County's fee schedule and includes more types of businesses than the County's schedule.

**4. Have there been cost savings from previous consolidations of city and county departments?**

Yes. Examples of past savings of consolidated departments are:

-Data Processing Mainframe consolidation (1995): first year savings of \$315,000.

-Parks and Recreation Departments consolidation (1993): first year savings of \$300,000.

5. **Would the budget and financial systems have to be integrated and is there a cost associated with that?**

Yes. It is estimated that the initial cost of converting to a common financial system could be \$400,000 - \$700,000.

**Service Questions:**

1. **How would consolidation affect the services?**

For all residents of the County, it could be easier to coordinate resources to provide services that address community issues and problems.

For residents of the current City of Charlotte, there could be clarity and accountability because only one government would be responsible for the services provided.

For residents of the Suburban Service District, the consolidated government would have the authority to provide some services not provided by local governments outside of cities earlier than normally occurs under annexation. An example of this is the authority to make transportation improvements if agreement is reached with the NC Department of Transportation to transfer this authority and State funding.

2. **Are there any changes proposed in the preliminary charter as to how water and sewer services would be provided?**

No.

3. **Are there any changes proposed in the preliminary charter as to how law enforcement would be provided?**

No.

4. **Are there any changes proposed in the preliminary charter as to how fire services would be provided?**

No.

- Charlotte Fire Department would continue to provide service to residents of the urban service district.

- Volunteer fire departments would continue to provide service to residents of the towns and the suburban service district.

5. **Are there any changes proposed in the preliminary charter as to how street construction and maintenance would be carried out?**

No, for residents of the Urban Service District and the Towns.

However, for residents of the Suburban Service District, the consolidated government would have the authority to provide transportation improvements if agreement is reached with the NC DOT to transfer this authority and State funding.

6. **Are there any changes proposed in the preliminary charter as to how solid waste collection would be provided?**

No.

- Public collection would continue in urban service district
- Private collection in suburban service district

7. **How would annexation and the provision of urban services to annexed areas be affected by consolidation?**

There would be no substantive change. The Urban Service District (former city of Charlotte) could continue to annex areas of the Suburban Service District as they meet annexation criteria. Some services would be provided upon the date of annexation as it is currently. Both the Urban Services District and the Towns could continue to annex in their respective "spheres of influence" areas.

### Debt Questions:

1. **How much debt do the City and the County bring to the merger and what was the money borrowed for?**

As of June 30, 1996, the City had \$859,355,000 of voter approved general obligation debt and \$497,291,365 of non-voter approved revenue bonds and certificates of participation. City projects include streets, water/sewer, storm water, airport, public buildings, parks, environmental protection, Coliseum, and cultural facilities.

As of June 30, 1996, the County had \$899,095,000 of voter approved general

obligation debt and \$6,312,000 of non-voter approved certificates of participation. County projects include schools, detention/jail facilities, community college facilities, libraries, parks, flood control, solid waste disposal, water/sewer and public buildings.

**2. How is this debt presently being paid?**

The City's FY 95-96 debt is paid from a dedicated 5.75 cents of the property tax as well as from dedicated revenue sources (i.e. water and sewer revenue, airport fees, hotel/motel occupancy, prepared food taxes, sales taxes, user fees, etc).

The County's debt is paid from property taxes and other revenue sources including user fees and sales taxes.

**3. Would the consolidated government be responsible for the debt of the City and the County?**

Yes. After successful referenda on consolidation and debt assumption, the government of the City of Charlotte would cease to exist and the new Metro-Government would assume its debt as well as the existing debt of Mecklenburg County.

**4. How would current City debt that is assumed by the consolidated government be paid? Would residents in the towns and unincorporated area have to pay for this debt?**

The Charter does not specifically address how the existing debt of the City of Charlotte would be paid once the government of the City goes out of existence. It was the intent of the Charter Drafting Committee that this debt would continue to be paid with taxes from the Urban Service District (former government of the City of Charlotte), as well as dedicated revenue sources that currently pay the debt (i.e. water and sewer revenue, airport fees, hotel/motel occupancy and prepared food taxes).

**Representation Questions:**

**1. What happens to the Charlotte City Council and the Mecklenburg Board of County Commissioners once consolidation takes effect?\***

Under the proposed schedule, following the approval by voters in the referenda on

consolidation and debt assumption and the approval by the General Assembly, the City and County governing boards would act together to prepare the transition plan for consolidation. Once consolidation takes effect on July 1, 1998, Council Members, Mayor, and County Commissioners then in office jointly serve as the initial governing body until a new Metro Council is elected and takes office. Primaries for the Metro Council would be held in May 1998, with general elections in November 1998. Members of the Metro Council would take office December 7, 1998.

\* (a different schedule, moving the effective date of consolidation to December 7, 1998, thus eliminating the transitional governing board, has been proposed by Councilmember Baker)

**2. What would be the terms of office of the mayor and council members of the new board?**

The initial term is three years in order to move elections to odd numbered years. Thereafter there would be two year terms.

**3. What would be the size of the Metro-Council and how would it be elected?**

The Metro-Council would be elected by districts and at large in a county-wide election. There are two representation plans under consideration for the Metro Government:

Recommendation of the Charter Commission:

11 council members (6 elected from districts and 5 elected at large) plus a mayor = 12

Plan approved by the County Commission:

13 council members (8 elected from districts and 5 elected at large) plus a mayor = 14

**4. How is this different from the existing governing bodies of the City and County?**

At present there are 11 Charlotte City Council members (7 district and 4 at large) plus a mayor = 12.

There are 9 County Commissioners (6 district and 3 at large, including the Chairman).

**5. How many minority seats would be available under these representation plans?**

Currently 3 of Charlotte's 7 district council members and one at large council member are minorities. Two of Mecklenburg County's 6 district commissioners are minorities.

Not taking into consideration the number of minority representatives that might be elected at large, including the position of Mayor, the following shows the number of minority seats for the two representation plans being considered:

-6 district/5 at large = 2 "minority" district council members out of 11  
-8 district/5 at large = 3 "minority" district council members out of 13

**6. Would elections be partisan or nonpartisan?**

Partisan.

**7. Would the Mayor and Council serve part time, as currently, or full time?**

Part time.

**8. Would the Mayor have a vote on the Metro Council?**

The Mayor would have no vote except in the event of ties, on protested zoning petitions, and on selection/dismissal of the Metro manager, Attorney and Clerk.\* The Mayor would have the right to veto any action adopted by the Council except for certain appointments, the adoption of the budget, and matters which must be approved by the voters. Any action vetoed by the Mayor could be overturned by the vote of 7 members of Council if there were an 11-member Council, or by the vote of 8 members of Council if there were an 13-member Council.

\* (County Commission action would include the Health Director, the Area Mental Health Director, and the Social Services Director)

**9. Would residents of the six towns in Mecklenburg County (not including Charlotte), continue to elect their town mayors and councils?**

Yes, town residents would continue to elect their mayors and councils in addition to electing the mayor and members of the Metro Council.

**Human Resources Questions:**

1. **How many City and County employees (positions) are there now?**

City (FY 95-96): 4,850 full time, 50 part time

County (FY 95-96): 4,227 full time, 97 part time

2. **Would there be fewer or more employees under a consolidated government?**

Fewer. Based upon the analysis of the City and County Managers, consolidation of the remaining departments that have not already been merged would result in fewer employees.

3. **Would there be adjustments in compensation/employee benefits that would increase/decrease the cost of the consolidated government?**

Depending on the decisions of the Metro Council, there could be additional costs or savings in the area of compensation and employee benefits.

**Legal Questions:**

1. **What is the document that would establish the consolidated government?**

The government would have a charter adopted by the N.C. General Assembly. The charter would dictate the structure of government and terms of office for elected officials and would provide a basic outline of how the new government would be administered. The ordinances, regulations, and administrative procedures needed to run the government would be left up to the transition board and future governing boards.\*

\*(If a different schedule is approved moving the effective date of consolidation to December 7, 1998 and eliminating the transition board as proposed by Councilmember Baker, the Metro Council would enact ordinances, regulations and administrative procedures.)

2. **The city and county have separate ordinances. How would they be combined?**

The ordinances would be combined by the two governing bodies working through the transitional phase of the consolidation.

**3. How could the Charter be changed in the future?**

The following areas could be changed by the vote of the people:

- name of the government
- style of the governing board (board of commissioners, board of aldermen, council)
- terms of office of the governing body
- number of members of the governing body
- mode of election of the governing body
- elections (partisan, non-partisan)
- method of selecting the mayor
- form of government

Any other changes to the charter would require approval by the General Assembly.

**4. What if the voters decide consolidation has not worked? Is there a way to undo it?**

Yes. State statutes provide for a procedure by which the General Assembly could unconsolidate the City and County based upon a locally prepared plan.

**Miscellaneous Questions:**

**1. Would citizens' mailing addresses change because of consolidation?**

No.

**2. Would consolidation affect local school funding and school board elections?**

Local funding support of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg School System (supplemental pay, construction and maintenance, etc.) would be determined by the Metro Council instead of the Mecklenburg Board of County Commissioners. There would be no change in the way school board members are elected or their duties and powers.

**3. Would consolidation change the powers of the Planning Commission?**

No.

**4. Would there be any changes in zoning laws due to consolidation?**

No.

**5. Would consolidation change the roles and responsibilities of boards and commissions?**

No, for existing boards and commissions.

The Amended Preliminary Charter authorizes the Metro Council to create a *Transportation Authority and an Airport Authority.*

**6. Would there still be opportunity to pursue privatization of services under a consolidated government?**

Yes. Both the City of Charlotte and Mecklenburg County currently have on-going privatization efforts. Consolidation would not prevent this from continuing.
