A Joint Meeting of the City Council and Board of Commissioners of Mecklenburg County was held in the Mayor's office, City Hall, at 4 p.m., on Wednesday, July 31, 1946, with Mayor Baxter presiding and the following members present:

For the City - Councilmen Childs, Hinson, Johnston, McIntyre, Newson, Puette and White.

For the County - Chairman McAden, Commissioners McEwen and Porter.

Absent for County: Commissioners Cashion and McDonald.

PURPOSE OF MEETING.

The Mayor stated the meeting was held for the purpose of appointing a Substitute Judge for the Domestic Relations and Juvenile Courts, to act in the absence of the Judge of said Courts.

APPOINTMENT OF RAY RANKIN AS SUBSTITUTE JUDGE OF DOMESTIC RELATIONS AND JUVENILE COURTS.

Chairman McAden stated the appointment of Mr. Ray Rankin, Attorney, as Substitute Judge had been recommended by the Judge of the Domestic Relations and Juvenile Courts and by the Secretary of the Charlotte Bar Association, and that the Board of Commissioners of Mecklenburg County approved the recommendation.

Chairman McAden moved that Mr. Rankin be appointed Substitute Judge of the Courts, to act as provided by law, at a salary of \$15.97 per day; said salary to be deducted from the salary of the Judge of said Courts, except during his vacation period and/or sick leave. Motion seconded by Councilman Childs, and unanimously carried.

ADJOURNMENT.

Upon motion of Councilman Hinson, seconded by Commissioner McEwen, the meeting was adjourned.
