AN ORDINANCE ORDERING THE DEMOLITION AND REMOVAL OF THE DWELLING AT 717 Sunnyside Ave. PURSUANT TO THE HOUSING CODE OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE AND ARTICLE 19, PART 6, CHAPTER 160A OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF NORTH CAROLINA, SAID BUILDING BEING THE PROPERTY OF Ernest L. Harris RESIDING AT Room 220, Johnston Building, 212 S. Tryon St., City

WHEREAS, the dwelling located at 717 Sunnyside Ave. in the City of Charlotte has been found by the Superintendent of Building Inspection to be unfit for human habitation and the owners thereof have been ordered to demolish and remove said dwelling, all pursuant to the Housing Code of the City of Charlotte and Article 19, Part 6, Chapter 160A of the General Statutes of North Carolina, and

WHEREAS, said owners have failed to comply with said order served by registered mail on the 12-21-71 and 1-20-72; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, that the Superintendent of Building Inspection is hereby ordered to cause the demolition and removal of the dwelling located at 717 Sunnyside Ave. in the City of Charlotte in accordance with the Housing Code of the City of Charlotte and Article 19, Part 6, Chapter 160A of the General Statutes of North Carolina.


AN ORDINANCE ORDERING THE DWELLING AT 1815 Luther Street
