An Ordinance Amending the City Code  
with respect to the Zoning Ordinance

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:

Section 1. That, Chapter 23, Section 23-8, of the Code of the City of Charlotte is hereby amended by changing from R-12 to O-15 on the Official Zoning Map, City of Charlotte, N. C. and Perimeter Area the following described property:

BEGINNING at a point on the centerline of Old Reid Road, said point being located two calls from the centerline intersection of Park Road and Old Reid Road 1) N. 38-12 W. 239.60 feet, 2) with the arc of a circular curve to the left having a radius of 510.49 feet an arc distance of 108.54 feet to the BEGINNING; running thence N. 31-14-22 E. 414.61 feet; thence N. 60-44-34 W. 434.62 feet; thence S. 21-57-50 W. 407.48 feet to the centerline of Old Reid Road; running thence with said line S. 60-22 E. 280.02 feet; thence with the arc of a circular curve to the right having a radius of 510.49 feet an arc distance of 88.96 feet to the point of BEGINNING.

Section 2. That, this ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN REVENUES AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO FINANCE THE SUGAR CREEK CANAL STUDY.


