ORDINANCE NO. 719-X

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS WITHIN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BUDGET TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR RELOCATION OF WATER MAINS IN STREET WIDENING PROJECTS.

BE IT ORDANINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte,
North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$50,000 is hereby transferred from Account 635.18 (Continuing Expenditures for Expansion of Services into Developing Areas) to Account 635.29 (Relocate Mains in Streets to be Widened), these funds will provide a supplemental appropriation to enable the Utilities Department to continue its program to relocate water facilities within conflicting areas.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.
