AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 1059-X, THE 1998-1999 BUDGET ORDINANCE, PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A WELFARE-TO-WORK GRANT FROM THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Charlotte:

- Section 1. That the sum of \$1,619,374 is hereby estimated to be available from the U.S. Department of Labor to provide funding for job-development of hard-to-employ welfare recipients.






