

AMENDING CHAPTER 3A

ORDINANCE 477

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 3A OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina:

Section 1. That Chapter 3A, Section 17, Subsection (i) of the Code of the City of Charlotte be amended by inserting a comma (,) after the word "religion", and the word "sex" before the word "or" in the last sentence of this subsection.

ORDINANCE NO. 478-X

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 176-X, THE 1971-72 BUDGET
ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND CONTINGENCY
TO THE TRAFFIC CONTROL BUDGET FOR TWO FLASHING STOP LIGHTS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North
Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$2,400 is hereby transferred from the General
Fund Contingency to Account 518.528 (Traffic Control - Traffic Signals), these
funds to be used for the purpose of erecting two flashing stop lights - one at
Kenilworth Avenue and Greenwood Cliff and one at Sharon Amity Road and Walker
Road.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.
