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ORDINANCE NO. 737-X

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 520-X, THE 1972-73 BUDGET ORDINANCE, TRANSFERRING FUNDS TO PROVIDE AN APPROPRIATION FOR A LEGISLATIVE LIAISON POSITION.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$3,600.00 is hereby transferred from Account 530.09 (General Fund - Longevity) to Account 530.48 (Legislative Liaison), these funds will be used to cover the City's share of the cost of a liaison position with the Mecklenburg Delegation to the North Carolina General Assembly. This appropriation is a 50 percent shared cost with Mecklenburg County and a like amount will be budgeted by the County.

RESIDING AT 10802 Hull Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio


WHEREAS, the dwelling located at 1135 N. College St.



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
