

- Section 4. This ordinance shall be effective immediately.



AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 4187-X, THE 2009-2010 BUDGET ORDINANCE, APPROPRIATING \$3,434,194 IN FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION (FAA) GRANT FUNDS, AND \$1,144,731.50 IN AIRPORT DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO BE REPLACED WITH FUTURE GENERAL AIRPORT REVENUE BOND PROCEEDS, FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A NORTHERN EXTENSION OF TAXIWAY 'D' INCLUSIVE OF THE RELOCATION OF A HANGAR AND PORTION OF MINUTEMAN WAY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Charlotte;

Section 1. That the sum of \$3,434,194 is available from FAA Grant Funds towards Taxiway D extension construction and associated projects.

Section 2. That the sum of \$1,144,731.50 is available from Airport Discretionary Funds towards Taxiway D extension construction and associated projects to be replaced with future General Airport Revenue Bond proceeds.


Section 3. That the sum of \$4,578,925.50 is hereby appropriated to the Airport Capital Budget: 2084 - 529.12.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.



Section 1. That the sum of \$17,302,493 is available from FAA Grant Funds towards Runway and Taxiway V projects.


Section 2. That the sum of \$17,302,493 is hereby appropriated to the Airport Capital Budget:






