

ORDINANCE NO. 139-X

An Ordinance Relating to Uniforms
Of Special Police Officers

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina:

Section 1. Uniforms and insignia worn by special police officers appointed pursuant to Section 66 of the City Charter, as codified, shall be distinct in color, design and markings from uniforms and insignia worn by regular and auxiliary police officers of the City of Charlotte.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption and shall apply to all special police officers referred to above now or hereafter appointed.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 1962-63 BUDGET
ORDINANCE TO TRANSFER APPROPRIATIONS WITH-
IN THE AIRPORT FUND.

ORDINANCE NO. 140-X

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North
Carolina:

Section 1. "SCHEDULE C. AIRPORT FUND" of Section 1 of the
1962-63 Budget Ordinance No. 107-X is hereby amended by trans-
ferring the sum of \$19,909 from "Anticipated Year End Balance" to
"Airport Operations", thereby changing the amount appropriated for
"Airport Operations" from "\$250,371" to "\$270,280", and changing
"Anticipated Year End Balance" from "\$221,056" to "\$201,147".

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.
