Properties located generally between Belvedere Avenue and the dead-end termini of DeArmon Drive and Logie Avenue and more specifically shown on the attached map.


Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 576-X, THE 1977-78 BUDGET ORDINANCE, AMENDING THE TABLE OF ORGANIZATION FOR THE CHARLOTTE-MECKLENBURG PLANNING COMMISSION TO ESTABLISH A SOCIAL PLANNING UNIT.

AN ORDINANCE TO TRANSFER FUNDS WITHIN THE PARK AND RECREATION CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO PROVIDE AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE RENOVATION OF MUNICIPAL SWIMMING POOLS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte,

Section 1. That the sum of \$216,000 is hereby transferred from the Improvements to Sugar Creek in Freedom Park Account (700.66) to the Renovation of Municipal Swimming Pools Account (700.68). These funds will be used for the renovation of the three municipal swimming pools.
