ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 9
ARTICLE I, SECTION 9-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9-13
ARTICLE I, CHAPTER 9, OF THE CODE
OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE TO PERMIT
SALES, FROM VEHICLES, OF ICE CREAM
FROM FREEZER DISPENSERS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE,
NORTH CAROLINA:

Section 1. Section 9-13, Article I, Chapter 9 of The Code of
the City of Charlotte is hereby amended by striking out the
first three lines of said section and inserting in lieu thereof
the following:

"It shall be lawful, subject to the conditions set
forth herein, to sell from motor vehicles operated
on city streets, (1) wrapped or packaged ice cream
products; (2) ice cream products extruded directly
from the freezer container in which they are produced
into a cup or cone at the time of sale and without
dipping or other handling."

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon its
adoption.
