ORDINANCE NO. 650-X

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS WITHIN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUND TO PAY FOR THE REMAINING SHARE OF THE WILMORE NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;


Section 1. That the sum of \$40,000 of current revenue is hereby transferred from Account 547.01 (Belmont Neighborhood Improvement Program) to Account 535.14 (Wilmore Neighborhood Improvement Program) and that the sum of \$90,000 is hereby transferred from Account 530.00 (General Fund - Contingency) to Account 535.14 (Wilmore Neighborhood Improvement Program), these funds to be combined with the \$100,000 appropriated by the City Council as a part of the Capital Improvement Program's budget to make up the City's share (\$230,000) of the total project cost for the Wilmore Neighborhood Improvement Program.

Section 2. That if at some future date, federal funds are made available to the City of Charlotte under general revenue sharing or community development programs, that consideration will be given to reimburse the City's General Fund - Contingency in the amount of \$90,000.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 651-X

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 621-X, THE 1972-73 BUDGET ORDINANCE PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE FINAL PHASE OF THE TOPOGRAPHIC MAPPING PROJECT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$227,000 is hereby transferred from Account 530.01 (Social Security and Retirement) to Account 635.82 (Topographic Mapping), this money to be used to provide funds to cover a contract with Abrams Aerial Survey for the final phase of the topographic mapping project.


Section 2. That this transfer is made subject to the condition that when the 1972 Water Bonds are sold, the General Fund - Social Security and Retirement Account will be reimbursed in the amount of \$227,000.

Section 3. If the 1972 Water Bonds are not sold by the end of the fiscal year, a portion of the year-end balance will be transferred to the Social Security and Retirement Account in the amount shown above.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
