Section 1. Chapter 19, Article I, Division 3, Section 19-26 of the Code of the City of Charlotte is hereby amended by deleting subsections (a), (b), and (f) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Sections 8, 15 and 19.ORDINANCE 17AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER SEVEN OF THE CODE OF THE

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina:

Section 1. Chapter 7, Article I, Section 8 of the Code of the City of Charlotte is hereby amended by deleting the words "one dollar and a half" and the figures "\$1.50", and substituting in lieu thereof the words "two dollars" and the figures "\$2.00).

Section 2. Chapter 7, Article I, Section 15 of the Code of the City of Charlotte is hereby amended by deleting the present rate as shown, and substituting in lieu thereof, a new rate as follows:

of Charlotte is hereby amended by deleting the words "one o'clock" and substituting in lieu thereof the words "twelve o'clock" in the sentence reading "Additional charge for opening graves on Saturday after one o'clock p.m., Sundays and holidays", and changing the figures "10.00" in the rate column to read "30.00".

Section 4. Chapter 7, Article 1, Section 15 (d) and (e) is hereby amended by deleting the present rate as shown, and substituting in lieu thereof, a new rate as follows:

"(d) Sowing grass

Half lot	10.00
Quarter lot	8.00

(e) Monument and marker foundations

Minimum charge for monuments	45.00
Price for foundations using over 1 cu. yd. concrete	7.50
Marker foundations	10.00"

Section 5. Chapter 7, Article 1, Section 15 (e) is amended also by the addition of the figures "(2xlx04)" after the words "marker foundations".

Section 6. Chapter 7, Article 1, Section 15(a) is amended by the addition of the following at the end of this subsection:

Wood box, steel and concrete vaults 50.00 + charge for  
air hammer

Section 7. Chapter 7, Article 1, Section 19 of the Code of the City of Charlotte is hereby amended by deleting the present rate as shown, and substituting in lieu thereof, a new rate as follows:

Quarter lot -----	6.00
