

ORDINANCE NO. 311

AMENDING CHAPTER 13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13 OF THE CITY CODE WITH
RESPECT TO THE REGULATION OF CONDUCT IN PUBLIC PARKS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte,
North Carolina, that:

Section 1. Chapter 13, Section 61 (1), of the City Code is hereby
amended by adding a provision at the end of the present subsection to read
as follows:

"... ; nor shall this provision apply to the sale
and dispensing of beer and wine in any park in
connection with community-wide celebrations of
national, state or city events on such occasions
and upon such terms as are approved by the
commission."

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon its
adoption.
