ORDINANCE NO. 588-X

STATEMENT OF RESULT OF
THE SPECIAL BOND ELECTION
held in the
CITY OF CHARLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA
on September 2, 1972

At a special bond election held on September 2, 1972
107,106 voters were registered and qualified to vote.

At said election 8628 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$6,250,000 Airport Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for enlarging and improving the Douglas Municipal Airport, including the acquisition of land for construction purposes and the construction of runways, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 8411 votes were cast against said ordinance, and a majority of the qualified voters of said City who voted thereon at said election having voted in favor of the approval of said ordinance, said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

At said election 8803 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$13,620,000 Sanitary Sewer Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for enlarging and extending the sanitary sewer system of said City, including the improvement of existing sewage treatment facilities, the construction, improvement and extension of sewage collection facilities and the acquisition of necessary land and rights of way, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 8202 votes were cast against said ordinance, and a majority of the qualified voters

of said City who voted thereon at said election having voted in favor of the approval of said ordinance, said ordinance was there-
by approved and is in force and effect.

At said election 8576 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$8,630,000 Water Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for enlarging and extending the waterworks system of said City, including the acquisition, construction, enlargement and improvement of water treatment and distribution facilities and the acquisition of necessary land and rights of way, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 8376 votes were cast against said ordinance, and a majority of the qualified voters of said City who voted thereon at said election having voted in favor of the approval of said ordinance, said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

At said election 8398 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$8,000,000 Street Widening, Extension and Improvement Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for widening, extending and constructing or reconstructing the surface of streets in said City, including the contemporaneous construction or reconstruction of sidewalks, curbs, gutters, drains and grading, and the acquisition of necessary land and rights of way, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 8574 votes were cast against said ordinance, and a majority of the qualified voters of said City who voted thereon at said election having voted ~~in favor of~~ ^{against} the approval of said ordinance, said ordinance

disapproved, not
was thereby approved and is/in force and effect.

At said election 7334 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$5,300,000 Street Land Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for acquiring land for streets and highways within the City of Charlotte, including streets and highways forming a part of the State Highway System, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 9342 votes were cast against said ordinance, and a majority of the qualified voters of said City who voted thereon at said election having voted ~~in~~ ^{AGAINST} favor of the approval of said ordinance, said ordinance was there-
by ^{disapproved} ~~approved~~ and is ^{not} in force and effect.

At said election 6891 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$3,100,000 Public Building Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for constructing on land owned by the City a new headquarters building for the Utility Department of said City, including the acquisition of any necessary equipment and constructing, as a part of the Model Cities program, a neighborhood center, including office space for departments and agencies of the City government and other public service agencies, for erecting and equipping additional fire stations in said City, including the acquisition of any necessary land, and acquiring land and constructing and providing facilities for use in training personnel of the police and fire departments of said City, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 9675 votes were cast against said ordinance, and a majority of the quali-

fied voters of said City who voted thereon at said election having
against
voted ~~in favor~~ of the approval of said ordinance, said ordinance
was thereby ~~approved~~ ^{disapproved} and is ^{not} in force and effect.

At said election 7855 votes were cast for the ordi-
nance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in
evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$1,500,000 Recreation
Facilities Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds,
with any other available funds, for acquiring land for public
parks and improving existing parks, including the improvement
of ancillary parking facilities, for improving existing City com-
munity recreation centers, and authorizing the levy and collection
of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the
interest on said bonds, and 8866 votes were cast against said
ordinance, and a majority of the qualified voters of said City who
voted thereon at said election having voted ~~in favor~~ ^{against} of the approval
of said ordinance, said ordinance was thereby ~~approved~~ ^{disapproved} and is ^{not} in
force and effect.

At said election 6823 votes were cast for the ordi-
nance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in
evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$4,900,000 Redevelopment
Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds for appro-
priation to the Redevelopment Commission of the City of Charlotte
to aid said Commission in the acquisition of land and the improve-
ment thereof by said Commission necessary in the carrying out of
its lawful powers and functions, and authorizing the levy and col-
lection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of
and the interest on said bonds, and 9733 votes were cast
against said ordinance, and a majority of the qualified voters
of said City who voted thereon at said election having voted ~~in~~
~~favor~~ ^{against} of the approval of said ordinance, said ordinance was there-
~~by approved~~ ^{disapproved} and is ^{not} in force and effect.

At said election 7257 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$700,000 Land Acquisition Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for acquiring land for a new City yard and for acquiring and preparing land for use in the disposal of garbage, refuse and other waste, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 9381 votes were cast against said ordinance, and a majority of the qualified voters of said City who voted thereon at said election having voted ~~in favor~~^{against} of the ~~approval~~^{disapproval} of said ordinance, said ordinance was thereby ~~approved~~^{not approved} and is ~~in~~^{not} force and effect.

At said election 7952 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$720,000 Bridge Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for constructing bridges in said City and acquiring any necessary land and rights of way therefor, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 8768 votes were cast against said ordinance, and a majority of the qualified voters of said City who voted thereon at said election having voted ~~in favor~~^{against} of the ~~approval~~^{disapproval} of said ordinance, said ordinance was thereby ~~approved~~^{not approved} and is ~~in~~^{not} force and effect.

At said election 8293 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$650,000 Storm Drainage System Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for improving the storm drainage system of said City, including the dredging of Sugar Creek, the construc-

tion of retaining walls, catch basins and other facilities for storm drainage and the acquisition of necessary land and rights of way, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 8502 votes were cast against said ordinance, and a majority of the qualified voters of said City who voted thereon at said election having voted ~~in favor of~~^{against} the approval of said ordinance, said ordinance was thereby ~~approved~~^{disapproved} and is ~~in~~^{not} force and effect.

At said election 7363 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$330,000 Municipal Equipment Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for acquiring traffic signals and signs, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 9268 votes were cast against said ordinance, and a majority of the qualified voters of said City who voted thereon at said election having voted ~~in favor of~~^{against} the approval of said ordinance, said ordinance was thereby ~~approved~~^{disapproved} and is ~~in~~^{not} force and effect.

At said election 8236 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$150,000 Sidewalk Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for constructing and reconstructing sidewalks in said City, including the acquisition of any necessary land and rights of way, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 8649 votes were cast against said ordinance, and a majority of the qualified voters of said City who voted thereon at said election having voted ~~in favor of~~^{against} the approval of said ordinance, said ordinance was thereby ~~approved~~^{disapproved}.
