**RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL

A motion was made by Councilmember Burgess and seconded by Councilmember Mitchell for the adoption of the following Resolution, and upon being put to a vote was duly adopted: unanimously.

WHEREAS, NCDOT authorized the improvement of US 74 from I-277 to Briar Creek and the placement of temporary traffic signals, existing traffic signal revisions, and new traffic signals on Independence Boulevard; and,

WHEREAS, A Municipal Agreement between the City and NCDOT is needed in order for the City to be reimbursed for traffic signal work already completed; and,

WHEREAS, The Municipal Agreement provides for the City to be reimbursed, by the NCDOT, for all work performed on this project, not to exceed \$295,000; and,

WHEREAS, The format and cost sharing philosophy is consistent with past municipal agreements,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Municipal Agreement between the North Carolina Department of Transportation and the City of Charlotte Department of Transportation, is hereby formally approved by the City Council of the City of Charlotte and the Director of Transportation and Clerk of this Municipality are hereby empowered to sign and execute the Agreement with the NCDOT.



**DECLARATION OF WITHDRAWAL OF DEDICATION  
OF RIGHTS OF WAY AND TERMINATION OF EASEMENTS**

**THIS DECLARATION OF WITHDRAWAL OF DEDICATION OF RIGHTS OF WAY  
AND TERMINATION OF EASEMENTS** is made this 10 day of April, 2006 by  
CENTEX HOMES, a Nevada general partnership (the "Owner").

**WITNESSETH:**

WHEREAS, by a plat of Cedarbrook Acres recorded in Map Book 8, Page 223 of the Mecklenburg County Public Registry (the "Plat"), Civil Development Company, Inc., a defunct corporation (the "Dedicator"), offered for dedication the following rights of way: (i) an unnamed sixty (60) foot right of way designated as "Area 1" on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; (ii) an unnamed sixty (60) foot right of way designated as "Area 2" on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and (iii) a portion of a sixty (60) right of way designated on the Plat as Denbur Drive and designated as "Area 3" on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, said Area 1, Area 2 and Area 3 being more particularly depicted on the Plat and on the survey attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Owner owns fee simple title to the land directly underlying Area 1, Area 2 and Area 3, and fee simple title to those lots and parcels of land located on both sides of and immediately adjacent to Area 1, Area 2 and Area 3, all as depicted on the Plat and Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Dedicator is not now in existence; and

**WHEREAS**, to the best knowledge and belief of the Owner, Area 1, Area 2 and Area 3 have not been actually opened and used by the public since they were offered for dedication more than fifteen (15) years prior to the date hereof, and the use of Area 1, Area 2 and Area 3 is not necessary to afford convenient ingress or egress to any lot or parcel of land sold and conveyed by the Dedicator or to any lot or parcel of land located adjacent to Area 1, Area 2 and Area 3 since all such lots or parcels of land are owned by the Owner and are to be re-platted in the future; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Resolution attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated herein by reference, the City of Charlotte has indicated that Area 1, Area 2 and Area 3 are not part of the street plan adopted under Section 136-66.2 of the North Carolina General Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Owner owns fee simple title to the land directly underlying Area 1, Area 2 and Area 3; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 136-96 of the North Carolina General Statutes, since the Dedicator is no longer in existence, it is conclusively presumed that the Dedicator has no further right, title or interest in Area 1, Area 2 and Area 3, and that the right, title and interest in Area 1, Area 2 and Area 3 is vested in those persons owning lots or parcels of land adjacent thereto, namely, the Owner; and

**WHEREAS**, by virtue of and under the deeds conveying fee simple title to the lots and parcels of land located on both sides of and immediately adjacent to Area 1, Area 2 and Area 3, the Owner may have a private easement and right of way over and across Area 1, Area 2 and Area 3; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 136-96 of the North Carolina General Statutes, the Owner desires to withdraw the dedication of Area 1, Area 2 and Area 3 from any public or private use to which the same heretofore may have been offered for dedication, pursuant to the Plat; and

**WHEREAS**, the Owner desires to terminate any easements and rights of way over and across Area 1, Area 2 and Area 3, if any.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the premises and the right to hold and own the land immediately adjacent to and underlying Area 1, Area 2 and Area 3 free and clear of any easements or rights of way, the Owner does hereby execute the following:


1. Pursuant to Section 136-96 of the North Carolina General Statutes, the Owner, for itself, its heirs, successors, and assigns, does hereby withdraw the dedication of Area 1, Area 2 and Area 3 from any public or private use to which Area 1, Area 2 and Area 3 may have been dedicated pursuant to the Plat.

2. The Owner, for itself, its heirs, successors, and assigns, does hereby release and terminate any private easements and rights of way, if any, over and across Area 1, Area 2 and Area 3.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Owner has caused this Declaration of Withdrawal of Dedication of Rights of Way and Termination of Easements to be executed as of the date and year first above written.





VICINITY MAP NOT DRAWN TO SCALE




