WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina (the State) annually provides Community Development Grants to units of government to assist in matching federal grants; and

WHEREAS, the City of Charlotte (the City) applied for a State Community Development Grant on August 13, 1980 to assist the City in matching an Urban Development Action Grant for the Woodland Business Park; and

WHEREAS, the State has officially notified the City that our request for funding has been granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, in regular session duly assembled, that the Mayor be authorized to accept the State Community Development Grant in the amount of \$30,000 and provide all assurances and documentation necessary for processing the grant award.


1. The City-County Tax Collector collected taxes from the taxpayers set out on the list attached to the Docket.
