

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF THE WORKABLE PROGRAM FOR
COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT RECERTIFICATION.


WHEREAS, the City of Charlotte, North Carolina is required to file before June 30, 1973 a biennial report reflecting the progress made in achieving goals under the Workable Program for Community Improvement, required by the Housing Act of 1949, as amended; and,

WHEREAS, the Advisory Committee on Urban Renewal and Community Improvement, a committee serving the Mayor and the Council, has prepared this submission; and,

WHEREAS, the approval of the City of Charlotte's Workable Program for Community Improvement by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development is necessary in order that the City will continue to be eligible for certain of the HUD-assisted programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor is authorized to submit the Workable Program in the form recommended by the Advisory Committee on Urban Renewal and Community Improvement to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development before June 30, 1973.
