At the March 24 dinner briefing, staff is scheduling a briefing on Duke's proposal to repurpose coal ash from Riverbend Steam Station at Charlotte Douglas International Airport in a structured engineered fill. As part of this briefing, staff has asked representatives of Duke Energy and Charah to present their proposal to the Council. In addition, staff has asked the Catawba Riverkeeper to also present additional information for Council's consideration. Lastly, staff will outline the process by which this due diligence review would be conducted.

Given the amount of information staff intends to provide to the Council and the other items on the dinner briefing agenda, staff are asking for the dinner briefing to start at 4:00 PM. Staff would use 4:00 to 5:00 to discuss the Duke proposal. Dinner would follow and the remaining two items on the dinner briefing agenda would then be presented.
