April 16 – Solid Waste Services To Host Public Ideation Session To Help Charlotte Reduce Waste

Solid Waste Services has partnered with Mecklenburg County Solid Waste and New Birth Charlotte Church to host Goodie Ideation [HEALTH], an event to develop big ideas to create solutions for improving personal health and creating healthier environments in under-served communities by reducing waste.

The event serves as the kick-off for Solid Wastes Services' [Healthy Communities program](#) and will take place on Saturday, April, 16 from 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. at the City of Charlotte's Solid Waste Services Building, 1105 Otts Street.

The Goodie Ideation [Health] Lab is the first phase in the 3-phase Goodie Innovation Process, which is designed to rapidly create solutions for social impact. During the 4-hour workshop teams of local residents will be introduced to a structured and proven process for developing innovative ideas for social change. Not only will they learn to generate solutions that work, they will also walk away with a cool technology-enabled idea ready to be passed on to designers and developers.

Solid Waste Services is on a mission to positively impact residents in Charlotte's under-served communities this year through the Healthy Communities program, and Goodie Ideation [HEALTH] is the first phase of that effort.

Water Purchase Agreement with City of Kannapolis

Throughout the years Charlotte Water has entered into a number of regional water and sewer service agreements with other local government units outside Mecklenburg County where no service was available. In these agreements Charlotte Water has purchased service from another system and/or provided service directly to that system.

The City of Kannapolis has a proposed development along the Mecklenburg County line just east of the Town of Davidson where Kannapolis does not currently have water lines. They have requested a water purchase agreement with Charlotte Water to provide the water service to this area until such time as they can serve it. Under the proposed agreement Charlotte Water would sell water to Kannapolis through one or two large meters at the county line. Charlotte Water would provide up to 500,000 gallons per day for an initial term of 10 years with the ability to terminate with sufficient notice.

This agreement will require a minor extension of the Charlotte Water system, but the costs will be borne by Kannapolis. The water lines that are constructed will be donated to Charlotte Water. Once Kannapolis constructs its water lines, the connection(s) would be maintained as emergency interconnects for use by Charlotte Water or Kannapolis. Kannapolis will pay the current rate charged under all similar agreements currently being used (third tier).
