On Friday, May 2, 2014, Neighborhood and Business Services will unveil four new vehicle wraps on Code Enforcement trucks. The trucks will be on display during the employee coffee at the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Government Center from 8:00 – 9:00 a.m. The images on the vehicle wraps represent the most frequent Code Enforcement nuisance violations: graffiti, high weeds and grass, parking on the lawn, and junk motor vehicles. The truck with the graffiti wrap is pictured below.

The trucks will be driven by Code Enforcement inspectors assigned to targeted neighborhoods in an effort to increase awareness about these violations. The idea for this enhanced educational effort originated from an employee suggestion for increasing proactive preventative efforts in neighborhoods.
