On Saturday, July 20, Neighborhood & Business Services will host the Second Annual Neighborhood Board Retreat in partnership with Foundation For The Carolinas. The Board Retreat, designed for neighborhood and business associations, will take place at the Foundation For The Carolinas offices at 220 N. Tryon Street.

The Board Retreat was created to help neighborhood and business associations engage in meaningful conversations about improving quality of life in their communities. Attendees will participate in facilitated vision planning discussions in order to set goals and priorities for the upcoming year, and develop strategic plans for improving their neighborhoods. Participating associations within the Neighborhood Matching Grant geography will receive a \$3,000 match credit towards their next application.
