Since the House and Senate finished up their work on August 2, the two chambers have been unable to agree on an adjournment resolution that schedules any extra sessions and the types of issues the General Assembly can take up. This leaves the resolution of issues such as Medicaid reform, coal ash management, revenue and economic development, and regulatory reform left hanging. Accordingly, the regular session is still ongoing and both chambers must meet at least every fourth day to meet constitutional requirements. August 14 and 15 have been tentatively set aside to consider any vetoes from the Governor, but there isn't any indication that any vetoes are forthcoming.
