CityLYNX Gold Line Phase 1 Construction

The CityLYNX Gold Line Phase 1 is preparing to enter into the third stage of special track work. The installation of these tracks will close the intersection of Caldwell and Trade Street between 4th and 5th Streets beginning on September 2. The intersection will remain closed until late October.

An announcement of the closure was distributed on August 28, 2014 via the Gov Delivery system and social media. That evening, WCNC requested a television interview to discuss the closure and the businesses inconvenienced by the construction. WCNC's piece, linked below, included interviews with businesses located at the corner of McDowell and Trade Street.

The Gold Line project team has been working in tandem with business owners throughout the entire construction process. The team has worked to maintain local access along Trade Street and adjacent properties during periods of road closure. The team has worked with property owners to allow for access to their driveways, or have made other arrangements for alternative access through an adjacent driveway. The project is still on track to open March 2015.
