September 10 – Business Opportunity and Outreach Symposium

CATS, in collaboration with E&PM and Charlotte Business INClusion, will conduct a Business Opportunity and Outreach Symposium on opportunities for businesses to create local jobs through the advancement of transit projects. The Symposium, the third event conducted in the past 18 months by CATS, will occur on September 10, 2013 from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. at the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Government Center.

Beginning this fall, CATS will be soliciting bids for several contracts for the LYNX Blue Line Extension. CATS is using this opportunity to create an environment that gives small and socially or economically challenged local businesses the opportunity to learn about publicly funded contracts by participating in the Small Business Enterprise (SBE) and the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) programs. As such there will be a “Meet and Greet” for potential prime and sub-contractors to learn about each other’s abilities and to develop working relationships for future contracts. Representatives from E&PM and Charlotte Business INClusion will also be on site to provide information about their programs and upcoming contract opportunities.

The event will begin at 9:00 a.m. in the Meeting Chamber. Breakout sessions will take place from 10:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. in the following rooms:
