October 5 – CLT Triennial Disaster Exercise

On Sunday, October 5, 2014 from 8 a.m. until noon, CLT will conduct its triennial disaster exercise. This full scale exercise is a FAA regulatory requirement, which certificated commercial service airports must conduct at least every three years. Tabletop exercises are permitted for the intervening years.

The exercise will depict a simulated airplane incident. The purpose of the drill is to exercise the Airport's communication and emergency protocols and the coordination of local and regional response agencies.

Approximately 100 volunteers will be on-site to play the role of passengers with minor and fatal injuries. More than 200 emergency responders, including the Charlotte Fire Department, Emergency Medical Services (EMS), Airport Operations, Airport Security, and Charlotte Mecklenburg Police Department will participate in the exercise.

Evaluators will be on-site to assess the overall drill and performance of the responders. The Airport will conduct an after-action review and make any necessary improvements to its emergency plan.

During the exercise, the public may see additional emergency vehicles, smoke, and other simulated crisis events. The Airport has broadly communicated the exercise to all of its partners/tenants, and will implement a communications plan on the morning of the drill to convey these events to as many customers as possible.
