Mayor and Council are invited to attend the 2016 Neighborhood Exchange & Leadership Awards tomorrow, Saturday, October 1, 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m., at the Charlotte Convention Center. Free parking will be available at the NASCAR Hall of Fame parking deck. The event will feature a networking breakfast, workshops, and an awards luncheon for neighborhood stakeholders.

The program's opening remarks will be given by Peter Kageyama, author of *For the Love of Cities: The Love Affair Between People and Their Places*, followed by two rounds of workshops and the presentation of eight Neighborhood Leadership Awards. Three new categories of awards are included this year, one for Neighborhood-School Engagement, one for Community Service (businesses), and one for Community Service (nonprofits).

Central Avenue Front Porch Swings

The Front Porch Swing project, funded by the John S. and James L. Knight Foundation's 2015 Knight Cities Challenge, was completed last week. Swings have been installed at five locations on the Central Avenue corridor—four near bus stops on Central Avenue and one at Charlotte Fire Station 8 in the Plaza Midwood Business District. Partners in the installation include Neighborhood & Business Services, Engineering and Property Management, Charlotte-Mecklenburg Police, Charlotte Fire, Central Pointe Apartments, Memorial United Methodist Church, Midwood International Cultural Center, and Sustain Charlotte.

The swings recall the southern tradition of welcoming front porches to create new conversation centers that connect people, improve the transit experience, and help bridge cultural and generational gaps. Construction Complete on City Boulevard Extension Project

Construction is complete on the City Boulevard Extension Project. Improvements include a four-lane, median-divided roadway with curb and gutter, bicycle lanes, planting strips, and sidewalks.

City Boulevard now extends University City Boulevard westward from its existing intersection at Neal Road to the proposed alignment of Mallard Creek Road near Rumble Road. The NCDOT Mallard Creek Extension project remains under construction, which the City Boulevard project will connect to. City Boulevard travel lanes will decrease from four lanes to two at Rumble Road. This traffic pattern will be used until the NCDOT's project is completed and the tie-in can be made.

I-77 Mobility Partners Traffic Advisory

I-77 Mobility Partners has issued the following traffic advisory:

Utility Work Scheduled Between Exits 11 and 12 Along I-77 on Saturday Night Beginning at 11:00 p.m.

Temporary traffic control measures will occur on Interstate 77 Saturday night, October 1, in both southbound and northbound directions between Exit 11 (Brookshire Freeway) and Exit 12 (LaSalle Street). Traffic flow will be slowed between 11:00 p.m. and 3:00 a.m. to allow crews to remove utilities near the interstate. Law enforcement will be on hand to assist with traffic.

Drivers may use alternate routes that include southbound I-85 to Brookshire Freeway and northbound Brookshire Freeway to I-85. Please be advised that ramps leading to this portion of I-77 during these hours will be temporarily closed.

- **WHO:** I-77 Express Lanes project
- **WHAT:** Temporary traffic control on I-77 in both southbound and northbound directions
- **WHERE:** Between Exit 11 and Exit 12 on Interstate 77
- **WHEN:** Saturday, October 1, 2016, 11:00 p.m. to 3.00 a.m.
- **WHY:** Removal of power lines by Duke Energy
