October 17 – Heavy Traffic Expected During Uptown Bobcats Event

The Bobcats preseason event, Cool School Field Trip, will take place at the Time Warner Cable Arena on Thursday, October 17, at 11:00 a.m. Attendance is expected to be 11,000 eighth grade students transported in over 225 buses. Heavy uptown traffic is expected starting at 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. On-street parking will be very limited in the areas around the arena including streets between College Street and McDowell Street, and streets between 5th Street and 9th Street. Additionally, the streets between 4th Street and MLK Blvd., and Brevard Street to McDowell Street may be utilized to park buses if needed. Commuters should plan accordingly.

School children will be crossing streets and walking to the arena from remote on-street and lot parking. Motorists are cautioned to be alert at all times.

Information regarding street closures and event details will be communicated to Uptown businesses and residents through the Street Use Notice report.
