CITY MANAGER'S REFERRAL

Referral of Real Estate Management Portfolio

I am referring the issue of Real Estate Portfolio Management to the Budget Committee for their consideration and recommendation back to Council. This issue is closely related to the City/County Real Estate Transfer Ledger that I referred to the Budget Committee on October 21.

At the September 7 Housing & Neighborhood Development Committee meeting, committee members recommended that Council consider repealing the 1994 Asset Management Guidelines that govern disposition of city-owned property. The original guidelines introduced a consistent process for disposition of surplus properties, aimed at maximizing revenue and tax base.

Staff is ready to plan for the repeal of the obsolete guidelines and to work with Council to develop a new policy directive that reflects the full scope of Council's priorities and interests in real estate and facility management.
