CityLYNX Gold Line Phase 2

During the Council Business Meeting, Mayor Pro Tem Cannon requested a report on potential development beyond French Street and Sunnyside Avenue.

Attached are copies of maps that show the entire length of the proposed Gold Line and reflect development potential beyond French and Sunnyside Avenue. Map 1 shows adopted area plans along the entire route. The second map shows potential development opportunities that were identified in either an adopted area plan or in the BAE Economic Development Study for the Gold Line. Similar information was shared with Council for Phases 1 and 2 of the Gold Line. The maps also reflect the additional information for Phase 3.

Concerns of Sandra Huerta

During the Citizens' Forum, Sandra Huerta requested funding for victims of gang violence and their families.

Deputy Chief Vicki Foster spoke with Ms. Huerta who explained that she wants to establish a fund to send victims of gang violence and/or their families to conferences. CMPD researched both federal and state grant programs but did not identify any that would fund travel to conferences unless the travel was part of a larger program funded by the grant.

CMPD feels that Ms. Huerta's best option would be to seek private funding through foundations or from businesses that are responsive to public safety concerns. CMPD suggests that she personalize the funding appeals and ask organizations to sponsor a specific person or family whose story she can share as part of the funding appeal. Deputy Chief Foster conveyed CMPD's suggestions to Ms. Huerta.
