Collaborative Partnership for Expanding Second Harvest Food Bank

During the dinner briefing on the collaborative partnership for expanding Second Harvest Food Bank, Council member Dulin requested information regarding the City's tree save and façade ordinances governing the agency's proposed expansion.

The Second Harvest Food Bank of Metrolina will be required to comply with all local land development ordinances (including the tree save ordinance), and any applicable options and variances that may apply. Engineering staff will contact executive director Kay Carter and make available the pre-submittal meeting for her and her design team. At that time, staff would be able to review the agency's plan and communicate the specific requirements for this particular site. The City will endeavor to partner with Second Harvest Food Bank to help them through the design and construction phase for the successful completion of their project.
