WHEREAS, the City of Charlotte is a vibrant community with a large business sector that includes thousands of locally owned small businesses in Charlotte and Mecklenburg County; and

WHEREAS, small businesses are a vital component of the Charlotte economy by creating quality jobs for our residents, engaging in philanthropic and civic concerns, helping to preserve neighborhoods and key business corridors, and improving the quality of life of our citizens; and

WHEREAS, support of local small businesses is critical to maintaining a robust and socially, environmentally and financially sustainable community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Charlotte values local small businesses and celebrates the diversity of goods and services they provide and the contributions they make to our community; and

WHEREAS, a significant amount of commerce in Charlotte and across the United States is conducted around the Thanksgiving Holiday during which Small Business Saturday occurs; and

WHEREAS, residents of Charlotte are being asked to support local small businesses on Small Business Saturday, November 30th, and throughout the year as a way to boost the local economy and strengthen Charlotte's small business community:
