To be eligible to submit an application for an applicant/agency must:

1. Meet all requirements found in the 16-17 ESG Application Instructions released by NC DHHS.
2. Submit signed certifications to Sandra Coley at Sandra.Coley@dhhs.nc.gov no later than **October 7, 2016**. (Please note: these must be future dated October 1, 2016 or later)
3. Be financially responsible for match requirement.
4. Participate in coordinated assessment process as detailed by the Coordinated Assessment Oversight Committee of the Housing Advisory Board.
