- Project Limits:
 - North Tryon Street to Rockland Drive



Rocky River Road West Street Improvements

Goals:

- Improve alignment and visibility
- Provide transportation choices including pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure
- Provide community connectivity
 - Light Rail
 - Toby Creek Greenway
- Reduce construction phases along the corridor





Rocky River Road West Street Improvements

- Deficiencies:

- Lack of continuous sidewalks and planting strips
- Lack of crosswalks
- Lack of dedicated bike facilities
- Limited sight distance



- Constraints:

- Two-lane section from Fortescue Drive to Rockland Drive






