The goals of this project are to improve the storm drainage infrastructure and to reduce flooding of streets and structures.

A sink hole was discovered under the sidewalk on 6th Street alongside Settlers Place (229 N. Church Street). This portion of the sidewalk and some of the on-street parking will be closed until this has been resolved. We
