YOUR STORM WATER FEES AT WORK

Dear Resident:

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services, along with consulting engineers W.K. Dickson and Associates, continue to work towards the completion of the preliminary design plans. Once the plans are complete, the real estate phase will begin. All property owners will be contacted to set up a short meeting to review the easements needed for construction and to discuss what will happen during construction.

Storm Water Services is currently on schedule as it proceeds with the design phase of the project.

Next Steps:

- Start easement documents
- Obtain construction permits from federal, state and local agencies

- Finalize design plans
- Begin construction
