Project Status

The project team continues to work with Duke Power, AT&T and Time Warner Cable for their infrastructure relocations. This collaboration requires the acquisition of six additional utility easements within the project area. During the next several months, the City will work with impacted property owners to acquire the necessary easements for private utility relocations.

Next Steps

When all easements are acquired, the City will finalize the construction drawings and start the bid phase. During the bid phase, the final drawings are circulated to qualified contractors for competitive bidding.
