YOUR STORM WATER FEES AT WORK

Dear Resident:

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services has started reviewing the easement plats for the real estate phase. This review defines the easement areas needed on private property for storm drainage work or utility relocations. As the utility companies provide information needed for relocations of their services to the project team, the easement plats will be finalized. All property owners will be contacted to set up a short meeting to review the easements needed for construction and to discuss what will happen during construction.

Storm Water Services is currently on schedule as it proceeds with the design phase of the project.

Next Steps:

- Complete easement documents
- Obtain construction permits from federal, state and local agencies

- Finalize design plans
- Begin construction


