Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and engineering consultant STV/Ralph Whitehead Associates are completing survey efforts and beginning to evaluate existing conditions in the Beckwith/Meadow project area. The project area borders The Plaza to the west, East Sugar Creek Road to the north, Shamrock Drive to the southeast, Briar Creek Road to the south and Matheson Avenue to the southwest.

When analysis of existing conditions is complete, a public meeting will be scheduled to present the findings and solicit input from project area residents

and property owners. Meeting details will be mailed to you approximately two weeks in advance.
