### ***Project Status***

The Beckwith Meadow Storm Drainage Improvement Project Team is finishing up the alternative analysis of the main storm drainage system. We have been working closely with Mark Grimshaw, Project Manager with Engineering & Property Management, on the Shamrock Drive Complete Street Upgrade Project. This project will make improvements to Shamrock Drive between The Plaza and Eastway Drive. Since the two projects overlap, design and construction will be coordinated to minimize construction impacts where possible. The City repairs, replaces and installs new storm drainage infrastructure when it deteriorates or becomes too small to handle increases in stormwater. Investing in infrastructure protects public safety, guards private property, improves water quality and enhances quality of life.

The Beckwith/Meadow Storm Drainage Improvement Project goal is to reduce flooding of streets and structures by improving the storm drainage infrastructure within the neighborhood.
