Dear Resident:

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services is in the final steps of the design phase of the Blenheim Storm Drainage Improvement Project. The necessary easements and permits have been obtained. The project goals are to update infrastructure, reduce flooding of structures and streets, provide emergency access, reduce erosion and increase stream capacity.

The next step will be the bid phase. During this phase, competitive bids are taken from responsible contractors to perform the work. After City Council approval, the City awards the construction contract to the lowest responsible bidder.



