Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services continues to work on the Blenheim Storm Drainage Improvement Project. The project goals are to update infrastructure, reduce flooding of structures and streets, provide emergency access, reduce erosion and increase stream capacity.

The consultant, HDR, continues to develop the design plans. Staff is working with various utility companies to identify which utility lines will need to be handled during construction. The City also continues to work with the residents who need to be relocated from flood-prone areas.
