Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and consulting engineer, The Isaacs Group, are continuing with the design phase of the Brentwood Place Storm Drainage Improvement Project. During this phase, construction drawings are developed for the recommended improvements. Many details have to be addressed, including channel widths and lining types, utility relocations and easements needed. The goal of this project is to improve the storm drainage infrastructure and reduce flooding of streets and structures.
