Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and engineering consultant, STV/Ralph Whitehead Associates, are designing the improvements for the Cedars East Storm Drainage Improvement Project. The project area is located between the Arcadian Village Apartments (formerly Idlewild Apartments) at the intersection of Idlewild Drive and Cedars East Court, just east of Independence Boulevard and the culvert under Amity Place.



The City has received utility company relocation approval and is now working to produce plans for project improvements requiring easements. Once completed we will schedule a public meeting to share the preliminary design plans.
