Project Status

With property and easement acquisition activities nearing completion, Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and engineering consultant, STV/Ralph Whitehead Associates, have begun preparing permits and final design construction drawings and specifications. Construction drawings, specifications and the necessary permits are expected to take several months to prepare, review and complete.

Next Steps

Following completion of this work the project will be advertised for bid to the construction community. The project area is located between the Arcadian Village Apartments (formerly Idlewild Apartments) at the intersection of Idlewild Drive and Cedars East Court, just east of Independence Boulevard and the culvert under Amity Place.
