The City repairs, replaces and installs new storm drainage infrastructure when it deteriorates or becomes too small to handle increases in stormwater. Investing in infrastructure protects public safety, guards private property, improves water quality and enhances quality of life.

The Chatham Storm Drainage Improvement Project goals are to reduce street and structure flooding throughout the neighborhood and address stream erosion to provide a more natural, stable stream system.
