


CHEROKEE/SCOTLAND

STORM DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

UNDER CONSTRUCTION



Contractor begins digging for sanitary sewer line replacement.

Construction is underway for the Cherokee/Scotland Storm Drainage Improvement Project. OnSite Development began laying new 8” sanitary sewer lines on Bolling Road and is continuing on Scotland Avenue. Sewer replacements are complete in advance of the new storm system running up Biltmore Drive. Sections of the old clay pipe were replaced with stronger iron pipe at locations where the new storm drainage system crosses over the sanitary sewer system.

Large tree removal is complete on Scotland Avenue and channel reshaping is currently underway for the creek running between Scotland Avenue and Twiford Place. Foundation protection began last week with one home being complete and the second one started. In the coming months, construction will continue along Scotland Avenue, Bolling Road and Biltmore Avenue.
