Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and consulting engineer, Dewberry Engineers, have completed construction plans and documents for the Cherokee/Scotland Storm Drainage Improvement Project. The project was advertised for competitive bids on October 20. The construction contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible contractor in January after City Council approval. Construction is scheduled to begin in the spring.
