Dear Resident,

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and City Real Estate representatives have met with Colonial Pipeline to address their remaining real estate concerns. Pending a successful resolution, easements should be acquired soon. Due to project delays a new design consultant will be selected over the next few months to finish the design plans.

The project goal is to improve water and environmental quality by restoring the primary stream from the Colonial Pipeline pond to Gum Branch to a more

natural and functional state. The project also includes improvements to the Colonial Pipeline pond to maximize the water quality benefits of the project.


